



Launch of the e-learning platform for the Customs Declaration System (CDS)

The UPU's Postal Technology Centre (PTC) is pleased to announce the availability of an e-learning platform for the training of postal operational staff.

This new e-learning platform will provide a more immersive end-user training for the UPU's IT products and services. The goal is to complement the deployment missions, workshops and remote training sessions conducted by UPU Experts.

Available now on the platform are courses on Electronic Advance Data capture (EAD) using the UPU's Customs Declaration System (CDS), sponsored by the Quality of Service Fund (QSF) Common Fund.

To login to the platform for the first time, simply create a new account using the links on the front page. A valid email address will be required to access the site.


Annex 1: Frequency asked questions (FAQs) – PTC e-learning platform

1) Is this platform a replacement for the UPU's TrainPost platform?

No. The TrainPost platform remains the official UPU postal training platform. The PTC e-learning platform is dedicated to technical training on the UPU IT tools.

2) How do I register to access the platform?

If you are a first time user, use the 'Create new account' button. A valid email address is required to complete the registration steps.



3) Can I (re)use the access credentials I already have for the UPU website?

No. This e-learning platform is dedicated to UPU member postal operational staff who usually do not access any private content of the UPU website. You will need to create a new account (connected to your email address) to access the course material.

4) What tools do I need to access the platform?

A modern browser and stable internet access are all you need to access the platform. The course content can be viewed on any device (desktop, tablet or mobile phone).

In addition, for offline access on your mobile device, you can download the free mobile App client provided by the platform. (Note: The PTC does not offer nor support this mobile App client at this time)






